New Things this year:

Monday – Math Day
Tuesday – Theme Day
Wednesday – Field Trip/Party Day
Thursday – Storytelling Day
Friday – Fun Day (not like the rest of the week isn't too – there will be a big focus on doing science and outdoor activity)

Helper of the Day – this will rotate (the chart will be on the side of the door, and children will be able to see when their turn is coming up).
